PAUL - Acts 18:23-19:20

Third Missionary Journey Begun; Paul Taught in Ephesus

1. Describe Apollos' knowledge of and zeal for the Scriptures when he arrived at Ephesus.

In what Christian doctrine was Apollos lacking? Acts 18:24-25

2. Who taught the Scriptures more accurately to Apollos?
What method did Priscilla and Aquila use? Acts 18:26

3. When Paul arrived in Ephesus on his third journey, had the disciples received the Holy Spirit?

Into what were the disciples in Ephesus baptized? Acts 19:2-3

4. With what baptism did John baptize? Acts 19:4

5. How did the 12 disciples in Ephesus respond to the teaching of Paul concerning baptism in the name of the Lord Jesus?

Paul laid his hands on the 12 disciples in Ephesus, and they received the Holy Spirit and began speaking with tongues and prophesying (a) before or (b) after they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. Acts 19:5-6

6. On Paul's third journey, how long did Paul stay in Ephesus?

How many living in Asia heard the word during this time?

Those hearing were (a) Jews or (b) Greeks. Acts 19:8, 10

7. Describe the miracles which God was performing through Paul in Ephesus.

How did many of those participating in magic show they were abandoning those practices? Acts 19:11-12, 17-19
