3 Woes from Jesus (Luke 6:24-26) (Woe 1) By: Aaron Cozort

Then He lifted up His eyes toward His disciples, and said: "Blessed are you poor, For yours is the kingdom of God. Blessed are you who hunger now, For you shall be filled. Blessed are you who weep now, For you shall laugh. Blessed are you when men hate you, And when they exclude you, And revile you, and cast out your name as evil, For the Son of Man's sake. Rejoice in that day and leap for joy! For indeed your reward is great in heaven, For in like manner their fathers did to the prophets. Luke 6:20-23

Luke 6 contains a similar set of verses as Matthew 5. Perhaps a subset of the beatitudes given on that occasion. When teachers come across a passage that seems very similar to another more familiar passage, some of them have a tendency to bypass that passage and reference the other, or treat it as identical. This is a poor practice born out of a lack of appreciation for the value of context. Luke 6 contains not only these blessings but also a series of three woes.

1. Woe to you who are rich... (Luke 6:24)

Jesus addresses the rich of this world; a group of people who often act as though they are above others and utilize their riches for their benefit. Not all rich people behave this way, but if their focus is on riches instead of spiritual matters, then they will ultimately receive the same woe.

What is the pronouncement of the woe? "For you have received your consolation." This message bears a connection to Abraham's message to the Rich Man of Luke 16.

"But Abraham said, 'Son, remember that in your lifetime **you received your good things**, and likewise Lazarus evil things; **but now** he is comforted and **you are tormented**." (Luke 16:25).

This declaration from Jesus declares the "end" of the rich... Hell and Torment. They are not condemned **because** they are rich, but instead because they love riches.

Paul wrote, "For the **love of money** is the root of all evil: which while some coveted after, they have erred from the faith, and pierced themselves through with many **sorrows**." (1 Timothy 6:10).

Some would consider those who have riches to be mean and vile people as are portrayed in many movies and satires, but the reality is that Jesus isn't addresses only those type of rich people. He is addressing the heart of a person who **loves** riches.

The rich young ruler seems to be one example. He was searching for eternity and spiritual answers, but he was also holding onto to covetousness in his heart. His unwillingness to lose his riches caused him to lose his eternal soul. (Cf. Matthew 16:26 - "For what profit is it to a man if he gains the whole world, and loses his own soul? Or what will a man give in exchange for his soul?").

There is coming a day when you will not be judged by your bank balance, balance sheet, or your profit and loss report, but instead by what you have done in this life.

For the Son of Man will come in the glory of His Father with His angels, and then He will reward each according to his works. (Matthew 16:27).
