5. What nation revolted against Judah during the reign of Jehoram (Joram)?

When God stirred up the Philistines and the Arabs against Jehoram, what did they do? 2 Kings 8:20, 22; 2 Chronicles 21:8, 10, 16, 17

6. Of what nation did Obadiah prophesy the destruction forever?

Why?

Of what nation did he prophesy continuance? Obadiah 1, 3, 10-14, 17-18

7. Who was Ahaziah's mother?

What kin was Ahaziah to Ahab? 2 Kings 8:16-18, 25-27
