Where does God dwell? Joel 3:2, 12, 21

6. What did king Joash of Israel say to Elisha, when Elisha was sick with the illness that he would die from?
After instructing Joash to shoot an arrow with a bow into the east, what did Elisha say?
Why did Elisha become angry with Joash?
Why was God gracious and compassionate on Israel during the time of king Joash? 2 Kings 13:14-19, 22-25
