God sent Judges over Israel, One great woman, fourteen men They helped Israel fight their battles Led them back to God from sin  Othniel, Ehud, Shamgar, Deborah, Gideon, Abimelech, Tola, Jair, Jephthah, Ibzan, Elon, Abdon, Samson, Eli, Samuel	1 Samuel-1 Samuel begins immediately after the book of Judges. The books of 1 and 2 Samuel together cover a period of over 100 years, from the birth of Samuel (about 1,100 B.C.) through the reign of David, not including his death. Samuel was the last judge, ruling over all the tribes (1 Samuel 7:15). The two books of Samuel tell the lives of Samuel and the two kings he anointed, Saul (1 Samuel) and David (2 Samuel).  Eli was the high priest and a descendant of Aaron. Samuel was not, however, a true priest. Even so, he acted as a priest on occasion (7:9; 9:11-14).
