1. What was the creditor going to take from the widow of the sons of the prophets? 2 Kings 4:1

2. What did Elisha instruct the widow to do with the jar of oil in her house? Then, what did he say to do with the many jars of oil? 2 Kings 4:2-7

3. What did the woman in Shunem perceive about Elisha? Name the special consideration she and her husband made for Elisha in their home. 2 Kings 4:9-10

4. What did Elisha promise the Shunammite woman who had been kind to him? Describe the illness and death of the Shunammite woman's son. What did the mother do when the boy died? 2 Kings 4:16-28

5. What was the Shunammite woman's response to Gehazi when he asked, "Is it well with you? Your husband? The child?" Tell what Elisha did when he restored life to the son. 2 Kings 4:26, 32-36

6. As the prophets at Gilead ate the stew, what did they say? Describe the miracle Elisha performed to make the stew safe for eating. 2 Kings 4:40-41

7. What did Elisha say to do with the barley bread and fresh ears of grain brought by the man? Why did his servant hesitate to obey? Describe the results. 2 Kings 4:42-44
